### Learning Activity 1:

The 6 steps are:

1. Isolate the person
2. Seek advice and assess the risks
3. Transport
4. Clean and disinfect
5. Identify and tell close contacts
6. Review risk management controls

### Learning Activity 2

Current health advice states that in order to reduce the risk of contact and droplet spread from a person, directly or indirectly, and from contaminated surfaces, people should maintain physical distance of at least 1.5 metres.

### Learning Activity 3

It is generally not necessary to clean and disinfect all equipment before or after each visit.

You should consider cleaning and disinfecting your equipment:

- before entering the home of a vulnerable or at-risk person, such an elderly person or a person with a pre-existing medical condition
- before and after sharing equipment with the resident of the home or with other people.
